Our membership covers a full range of skill and experience from just starting out novices, up to members with considerable knowledge and large collections, but we try to support each other and mutually advance our knowledge and skill whenever we can. This yearly club event does just that. We all had a good time and came away with better insights about our specific trees and bonsai in general. I hope that next year more of us participate.

Since the beginning of Bergen Bonsai, 73 years ago (give or take a few decades), we have gotten together sometime in early Dec to eat, enjoy each others company and perhaps talk about the club and even our trees. Next meeting is that time again and we should all attend. The food and the place are very good and at \$15 a person the luncheon is also a good deal. Bring spouses or friends for this Bergen Bonsai tradition. Please notify either Ralf or me that you are coming and pay your dues for next year at this luncheon.

Bergen Bonsai Changes

Our Board had a meeting in October to plan next year's program and to discuss the status and health of our club. The proposed 2019 program is included in this newsletter. There are many strengths that Bergen Bonsai has, but most notably we have an active core group with years of experience both on the club level and with Bonsai itself. We all have a strong desire to continue meeting the needs of members and to keep the club strong, but the main focus of the club remains to learn how to make and maintain good bonsai.

Over the past three to four years both membership and participation has declined. Many old time members have died or moved away from this area and they cannot be replaced, although I am optimistic about some of new people who have recently joined. In addition participation in club programing , particularly for paid visiting artists, has not been sufficient to prevent a significant shortfall in our operating budget last year.

In order to both improve on our primary focus and also reduce costs, we are proposing the following changes starting next year.

a) We will continue using the Closter Center, which costs \$160/meeting, for prime events when attendance should be high, but we will be using the Teaneck Greenhouse location (\$400 / year unlimited number of meetings) at other times.

b) In an effort to involve members in substantially improving a select group of two to four trees we will shift to a study group format for meetings with a quest artist. A single visiting artist will be coming four times in the next two years, in the spring and in the fall. There will be no lecture demo, but instead only all day workshops. The program will be open to all members at a cost of \$100 total for all four workshops paid up front , with no refunds for missed sessions. The same two to four trees should be worked on at each of the four sessions.

c) The trees that you use, at whatever stage of development, have to have the potential to become substantially better. Acquiring them for the first meeting in March is a prime objective.

d) We may have additional visiting artists during the year, but we are selecting Tyler Sherwood as the main artist for our club. More will be said about this plan.

The Board of Directors election.
